

Press Release – Forensic Audit of Mobile Telephone Records

Recent media reports and concerns expressed directly to me as Commissioner for Privacy and Data Protection allege that significant privacy issues arise from an alleged audit of mobile telephone records for telephones used by Victorian politicians and public servants.

As a result of those reports and concerns, I have today written to the Premier of Victoria seeking information regarding that alleged audit.

This enquiry, made under section 79 of the *Privacy and Data Protection Act 2014*, seeks to determine whether any breach of the Information Privacy Principles has occurred.

I will report publicly on the outcome of this enquiry, once it is complete.
